

# SHKODRA LAKE "Protected Area"

- Skadar/Shkodra Lake is situated in the western part of the Balkan, in the border between Albania and Montenegro
- The watershed of Skadar/Shkodra Lake surface-5179 km2
- 500.000 inhabitants in Albania and Montenegro
- Important reserve of biodiversity and a migratory road for many animal species of the region. – RAMSAR Site
- 5-9 m/ the deepest 60 m eye of radues
- 1-2 times/year replace /refresh the water due to the undergrounds resources

### Aim & Objectives

#### AIM:

Increasing knowledge on Skadar/Shkodra Lake and collaboration between the two countries not only in the environmental aspect, but also in scientific, cultural and sustainable development terms.

# 1. Promoting cooperation between institutions and organizations dealing with management of water resources



Multi stakeholders Approach: MoE AL-MNE, NP MNE, Municipalities AL-MNE, Research Institutions AL-MNE, Universities AL-MNE, REA -AL, INP MNE, Education Institutions, NGOs, End Users, etc

- In May 2003 a MoU for the Protection and Sustainable Development of joint resources was signed by the Ministers of Environment AL-MNE
- In Nov` 2005, AL side of the lake proclaimed Management nature Reserve IVth IUCN
- In Feb 2006 AL side of the Lake proclaimed RAMSAR site
- In June 2007 AL MNE recognize & proclaimed THE DAY of Shkodra/Skadar Lake
- June 2007 Municipalities of Shkodra (AL) & Cetinje (MNE), signed Statement
  of Cooperation committed to conserve the natural resources of Skadar/Shkodra
  Lake and extend the cooperation on the field of eco-tourism and culture.
