The water agencies are 50 years old


After the second world war 1939-1945, big growth (industries, agriculture, population)

- → Big needs of water, big pollutants discharges
- → Big issues

1964 water law - management unit: river basin; water community: basin committee; ear-marked charges (water consumption, pollutants discharges); basin financial agencies (now called water agencies)

1992 water law: well-balanced management « ecosystems / uses »; planning tools


2006 water & aquatic ecosystems law: new ear-marked charges



How to build an action plan: Set of actions *« Osmose »*

 The French universal set "Osmose" is a new set of actions, used by all the water agencies for their own action plan.

 The actions are organized by theme: agriculture / sanitation / governance-knowledge / industry / aquatic ecosystems / resources.



How to build an action plan: Set of actions *« Osmose »*

The national set (catalogue) "Osmose" contains 164 measures (actions): 90 contractual actions (works, assessments and governance), 32 regulatory actions (permit system, regulatory action plans), 42 control actions.










Public services coordination within department

Water interservices mission

- In France, in each "department", the activities of the water interservices mission
 - consist of: regular meetings with state services, training, controls, coordination, awareness, assessment, coherence of the plans (land management, quarries...)
 - Managed by: the deputy director of one public service (# agency Lao) or someone close to the Prefet (# Governor Lao); approximately 30% of one full-time-equivalent (FTE)
 - With operational relationships, no hierarchy between services



100 departments
One department # 6,000 km²



Water interservices mission: duties

PLANNING - COORDINATION - EVALUATION - COMMUNICATION

In the name of the Prefet of the department, the water interservices mission is the body responsible for:

- 1. Declining the water policy and aquatic environment in the department (identifying local issues and priorities)
- 2. Providing an operational action plan for implementation of the water policy and ensuring the consistency of public funding
- 3. Representing the position of the State in planning documents and towards the larger works that have an impact on water
- 4. Ensuring coordination with related policies: health policy, risk prevention, land development...
- 5. Ensuring the integration of water policy into sectoral policies carried by the decentralized public services
- 6. Assessing the implementation of the water policy of the State within the department
- 7. Organizing the communication and exchange of data on water within the department



Water interservices mission: operations

- Once a year: strategic committee (CEO of decentralized public services and water agency) to set priorities and actions, to validate the results of the past year and the program for the next year.
- Each month: permanent committee (# 10 representatives of decentralized public services, 1 representative of water agency) to monitor the implementation of the water policy, to coordinate the actions, to share experiences, to survey sensitive projects, to prepare strategic committee meetings...
- If necessary, working groups about specific topics.
- Twice a year: national meeting organized by the direction of water and biodiversity (ministry of sustainable development) with all the chiefs of the water interservices mission.
