

Dniester and Prut rivers basins MAP

In order to manage the water resources on the "Basin Principle" in the Republic of Moldova has been approved Governmental Decision 775 dated on 4 of Oct 2013 (Appendix 1), which has established the boarders of the Dniester and Prut rivers basins.



Agreements. Challenges

- Agreement RM-Ukraine on the Dniester <u>river</u> (1994).
- New Agreement RM-Ukraine regarding protection and sustainable evolving of the Dniester <u>basin</u> (2012).
- Agreement RM-Romania regarding cooperation on protection and sustainable use of the water resources of the Prut and Danube <u>rivers</u> (2010).

The Dniester river basin management plan – DRBMP

- DRBMP is elaborated by financial support of USA and is extended for 6 years (2017-2022)
- DRBMP aims at the protection, improvement and sustainable use of the water ecosystems. An action plan was defined.
- DRBMP is elaborated based on art.19 of National Water Law 272 from 2011, transposing the Water Framework Directive.
- DRBMP should be approved by Govern. Decision this year and then implemented

Prut River Basin Management Plan – PRBMP

- 1st Prut RBMP was elaborated within the project EPIRB environmental protection of international river basins;
- The integration of Danube and Black Sea sub-basins into Prut RBMP is on going;
- Transboundary cooperation aspects were considered;
- Guidelines for the elaboration of RBMP and their implementation;
- It should be approved by the Government and then implemented
