Background

The regional process has been a key element in the World Water Forum since 2003. The purpose of the regional processes is to discuss measures to address water issues in relation to a specific regional context.

The European regional process has been facilitated by Netherlands Water Partnership (2006), European Water Partnership (2009) and Europe-INBO (2012).

Topics

The following Action Goals for the thematic process have been identified by Forum organisers:

1. A water-safe world for all
2. Water for Development and Prosperity
3. Water for Harmony between Humans and Nature
4. Implementation mechanisms

The European topics should link to these and reflect water related challenges in the whole European region as well as the objectives of the Science and Technology Process which are to:

- Improve the understanding of the role of S&T for innovation in the water sector,
- Develop guidance on the use of S&T to implement and innovate water policies
- Create market and network opportunities for water problem owners to interact with science, technology and engineers.

Stakeholder consultation in Korea


During the 2nd Stakeholder Consultation Meeting held in Korea 27-28 February 2014 present European stakeholders made a preliminary discussion of topics to serve as a starting point for the discussion:

1. Improving water efficiency
2. Climate change and water management
3. Integrated implementation of EU directives
4. Transboundary water management
5. Responsibility for the global development – water and SDG's

Implementation mechanisms were also discussed such as economics and financing, Horizon 2020, Partnerships and Implementation of EIP Water, Solidarity Financing Mechanisms.

French Water Partnership and Danish Water Forum, the regional coordinators will now start to identify European sub-coordinators, who will volunteer to take responsibility for facilitating certain topics and to conduct the thematic meetings within that topic.
